Summary

PeaceWin has significant experience in the areas of food security, nutrition, and climate change. In terms of food security, the organization focuses on sustainable agricultural practices and enhancing community resilience to ensure consistent and reliable access to food. For nutrition, PeaceWin promotes education on healthy eating and provides access to nutritious food, with the goal of reducing malnutrition among vulnerable populations. Regarding climate change, PeaceWin is involved in raising awareness about the issue, implementing climate-resilient agricultural techniques, and developing disaster risk reduction strategies to mitigate the impacts of climate-related events. The organization collaborates with both local and international partners to tackle the intertwined challenges of climate change and food security. Ongoing projects are designed to integrate climate adaptation measures, ultimately aiming to improve food security and nutritional outcomes for the communities they serve.

1. Ongoing Projects

The focus on quality and inclusive education, child rights, and disaster risk management is exemplified by the Integrated Community Development Project in Bajura, funded by Good Neighbors International with USD 626,014.02 from September 2016 to December 2025. Additionally, efforts to raise awareness about gender-based violence (GBV) and sexual and reproductive health rights (SRHR) are evident in the Gender Based Violation Prevention and Response (GBVPR)-II Project, spanning Bajura, Achham, Bajhang, Baitadi, and Kailali from August 2021 to December 2024, supported by UNFPA/VSO with USD 453,390.60. Infrastructure improvements are highlighted by the ongoing community bridge construction in Bajura, financed by TBSU/Local Palikas with USD 143,573.69 since July 1999. Furthermore, initiatives to combat child marriage, including child club formation, skill and knowledge development, and local government policy formulation, are addressed by the Ending Child Marriage Project in Bajhang and Baitadi from January 2022 to December 2024, funded by UNFPA/VSO with USD 56,673.83.

2. Local Food System and Nutrition

Over the years, numerous projects have been initiated to tackle the critical issues of food security, nutrition, and climate change, each funded by a range of organizations. For instance, the Community Action for Livelihood Project by CARE Nepal, running from January 1992 to December 2009, received USD 9,492.31. Similarly, the Income Support Program by the Ministry of Local Development Targeted Development Section, from August 1997 to July 1998, was funded with USD 755.65. Other notable projects include the Women's Leadership Development and Empowerment Programme by CARE Nepal, receiving USD 41,222.44 from January 2002 to November 2010, and the Empowerment of Poor and Marginalized Sections Program by Action Aid Nepal, with an impressive USD 377,825.57 from March 2008 to December 2022. These efforts highlight the sustained commitment to improving livelihoods and resilience against climate change through targeted support and development initiatives.
