



1. Background

PeaceWin Bajura was established on 27 October 1990 at Bajura district. Its center office is in Badimalika Municipality-9 Bajura. It has been registered at the District Administration Office in Bajura. It is affiliated to the Social Welfare Council on 2 February 1999. It works to address the Child Rights and Quality Education, Women Leadership, Gender & Development, and Inclusion, Infant-maternal nutrition, HIV and AIDS, sanitation, Disaster Preparedness, Good Governance and Youth empowerment.

PeaceWin made the partnership agreement with Good Neighbors International Nepal for the implementing of the Community Development Project in Budhiganga Municipality and Chhededaha Rural Municipality of Bajura district on 20 September 2016. After successful completion of CDP, PeaceWin is implementing ICDP from 2022. Good Neighbors International Nepal funded ICDP has been also implementing in 31 schools, 25 ECDs, 8 Health Posts of Khaptad Chhededaha Rural Municipality and Budhiganga Municipality of Bajura in 2024. In the same way MHM follow up activities were conducted in Tribeni Municipality, Gaumul Rural Municipality and Badimalika Municipality of Bajura district. Education, Public Health, Child Protection and CCT thematic area related activities have been also implemented at community through PeaceWin in 2024.

Integrated Community Development Project is also implementing some additional activities in crosscutting themes: gender equality, advocacy, disaster risk reduction, environment management, partnership and networking along with our core thematic programs.

Poorest of the poor children, their parents, disadvantaged and marginalized communities, people from remote areas, community based organizations (school, health post, cooperative, mothers group, farmer group, self-help group, SMC, PTA, child club, youth club, HFOMC, VCPC, S-WASH-CC, and FCHV) are main beneficiary target groups of the project

- the good practice and prepared the teaching learning materials in organized school.
- Two school buildings have been constructed by the project with budget sharing from the local level in Budhiganga Municipality and Khaptad Chhededaha Rural Municipality.
- Parental Fair Program was motive to all children and parents toward reading and learning.
- Additional classes were conducted in 15 schools for SEE preparation classes, which focused on English, Mathematics, and Science subjects.
- ECED children was continuously attended to the classroom after established the SMART TV.

Health and Wash

- 2 Sponsor Children Aksha Rawal and Basanta Rawat got critical treatment support from ICDP.
- ➤ Total 62 FCHV mobilized for enhancing the knowledge of 1765 mother group members on MHM in community level.
- More than 126 students and teachers are being access of drinking water through DWS maintenance at Mahendra B.S.
- ➤ Total 1258 sponsor children and 367 non sponsor children were checked their health for supportive to make healthy life.
- Through the traditional healer mobilization, total 5165 community people got knowledge on MHM. They are self-committed for reduce menstrual stigma at community level.
- ➤ Total 252 health worker gave commitment in delivering the adolescents friendly service from health post.
- ➤ On MHM Day 138 people committed to stand against menstrual stigma by signing on commitment banner.
- > Total 16 MHM clubs are reformed and supported some operation materials which are supportive for activation of MHM club.
- > School level speech competitions have been conducted on titled

- "Dignified Menstruation, our Responsibility at Tolidevaldada SS and Bhanodaya SS. More than 500 students were informed about the MHM through those programs.
- ➤ Total1466 children got food items i.e. lentils, wheat flour, oil and this is supportive to reduce the financial burden.
- Gaumul Rural Municipalty has started general health check-up from primary level students on palika self-initiation.
- ➤ Badimalika Municipality has started to provide MHM knowledge and health counselling from Malika Model secondary School through one school one nurse program.
- Budhiganga Municipality, Badialika Municipality, Tribeni Municipality and khaptad Chhededaha Rural Municipality have finalized draft Dignified Menstruation Management Guidelines which will be passed from winter Palika assembly.

- ➤ Child Marriage Status Survey was completed in Khaptad Chhededaha RM.

- 8 ward level CRC are active and conducted the bimonthly and made decision for children.

- Strategic Workshop of Child Protection Mechanism made the plan for ending child marriage and child protection.

3. Activities in Details

3.1. Education

Education is one of the core components of Integrated Community Development Project (ICDP) and it aims to improve children's access to education facilities and enhance capacity of community schools to deliver quality education. The education related activities of ICDP mainly focuses on improving the access to quality education of children in education, improving school management and accountability and enhancing school resilience. The following education related activities are conducted in community:

3.1.1. Improved access to and quality of education

Parental Education

The Parental Education Program (Parents Interaction Program) was conducted at different 4 places with community and respective schools in Lisana, Budhabada of Khaptad Chhededaha Rural Municipality, Nimani and Khulalbada of Budhiganga Municipality of Bajura. Total 21 activities of Parental Education was conducted, where the same way 8 event Interaction with Parents, 6 event Family School Sharing Meeting, 4 event Story Telling and 1 Parental Fair was conduted. These Parental Education sessions were facilitated by School Teachers and EPO. In the parental education session, parents were gained the knowledge on the role and responsibilities towards their children i.e., important of education and sending children to school, important of reading corner at home and parent's role of management of reading corner at home etc. There were 819 participants (including Parental Fair) participated, and They were aware of their role and responsibilities towards their children. All participants were motivated to establish a reading corner at home and support children in achieving the better result of their children.

Traditional Healer Support for community mobilization (CDP area)

Traditional Healers were mobilized in working area of ICDP area Budhiganga Municipality and Khaptad Chhededaha Rural Municipality of Bajura district to reduce menstrual taboos on community level. From the traditional healer's mobilization, total 1704 (children: 71 boys, 292 girls; adult male 342 female 999) participants participated in this year 2024. This were facilitating to community people and schools level students about religious factors towards menstruation, ways of stigma reduction, myths and facts about menstruation etc. This mobilization is being very interesting and effective for reduce Chhaupadi malpractice in Khaptad Chhededaha Rural Municipality and Budhiganga Municipality of Bajura district.

Taking the power of IEC materials to raise awareness in the community, Peacewin Bajura has planned to produce IEC materials against child marriage and demonstrate them in different public places such as markets, educational institutions, health institutions, etc. under ICDP.

Housing Support

Bishna Kumari Dhami, registered under sponsorship code NPL-0119-002269, is a resident of Khaptadchhededha Rural Municipality, Ward No. 4, in Bajura District. During the last monsoon season, the roof of the house collapsed, allowing rainwater to flood the interior, which led to further damage. Lacking the resources for immediate repairs, the family was forced to abandon the house and now lives in a temporary plastic shelter. Currently the family are highly at risk of wild animal attack, snake or insect biting as well as having no environment for study at home. Identifying that the family has needed support to reconstruct the house to make the life of the child and her family easier and protect from risk. Housing support is smoothly ongoing to close coordination with LG.

Death Consolation Support

The child AARESH KC (Code NPL-0119-002220) was suddenly ill. His treatment was going on at Balayapata Hospital, but Bayalpata Hospital referred the child to Dhangadi for further treatment. On the way from Bayalpata to Dhangadi, he was dead on 28/12/2080 BS. So, we supported rice 2 packs, Pulse 8 Kg and oil 20 Packet for supporting death function.

In the same way child Sunil Tiruwa's family, Sunil Tiruwa (Code NPL-0119-001440) was suddenly ill. His treatment was going on at Dindiwal Hospital but Bayalpata Hospital, but he died on 28/01/2081 BS. So ICDP also supported food items 1 pack cooking oil, 2 sacks rice, 8 kg Lentil mix, 2 sacks flour to his bereaved family.

The project areas all Municipalities and Rural Municipality have focused MHM issues on their policy and program FY 2080/81. It supports to make more active MHM campaign on the community level. This is the achievements of local level coordination and collaboration.

> Traditional Healers activeness for reduce menstrual stigma:

Traditional healer's mobilization is being very effective for reduce menstrual discrimination a harmful practice on our society. Altogether more than 20 THs are engaging in different types of workshop meetings etc. right now. This helps to break traditional misconceptions towards menstruation.
